SNOW REMOVAL

Now that it's winter... it's time to think about winter safety.

- To keep our community safe all sidewalks need to be clear of any snow and ice. **SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCE WILL BE ENFORCED.**
- **DO NOT** shovel, snow blow or push snow out onto or across the roads (this is a **STATE LAW**).
- Make sure that your mailbox is sturdy. The Borough is not responsible for any damage to your mailbox from snow removal procedures. Snow-pow resistant mailboxes are available locally or on-line. All mailboxes must be shoveled out to insure mail delivery.
- Keep all swales clear of leaves and debris 12 months of the year to prevent any stormwater problems.
- Trash cans should be on the right side of your driveway (facing the road) and **NOT** in the road.
- If there's a major snow storm and trash cans have not yet been picked up please don't leave the trash cans out by the road. **BRING CANS INSIDE.**
