- *No grass clippings, leaves or yard debris

Some items worth mentioning that we **cannot** believe have been place in the recycling containers

- *Car seats
- *Deer parts from butchering
- *Christmas/holiday lights
- *Tow chains

All of the above are trash/garbage. There is an increased effort to keep recycling clean.

(including Aerosol Cans)
Aluminum Foil
(pie plates, eg.)
Plastic Containers

Unacceptable Items:

NO Trash, NO Diapers, NO Clothing, NO Styrofoam,
NO Caps or Lids, NO Food, NO Compost, NO Yard Waste
NO BAGS

Please Place Items in Cart Loose
All Cardboard Must be Flattened
NO Shredded Paper (Place in Trash)
NO Bags of Shredded Paper (Place in Trash)
